## Downriver Senior Olympics GOLF

- 1. Teams will consist of four (4) players, to be randomly selected. A request to name one (1) partner is available, as the person must also request your name.
- 2. The "Scramble" concept will be used in the 9-hole competition, each team member drives and the best one is chosen, each player then hits from that spot. This format is used on each shot, including putts.
- 3. USGA Rules govern all play except where local rule prevail.
- 4. Winter Rules: In this "scramble" format you may improve your lie with the clubhead. You must not move the ball to avoid a hazard, bunker, trees, etc...
- 5. Out of Bounds: Lost ball, drop ball two club lengths from place original ball went out or was lost. O It will be a one (1)stoke penalty.
- 6. Water Hazards: Ball in creek or pond, drop ball close to where the ball entered the water. One (1) stroke penalty.
- 7. If a team has less than four (4) players for any reason, one extra shot per hole is taken for each missing player. These shots will be taken alternately by members of the team.
- 8. Special Holes: Each golfer is automatically entered into the Longest Drive and Closest to the Pin contest. There are participants for each age division!
- 9. Awards will be given by gender and class category: ties are possible and may be based on hole difficulty (par) to determine best score if too many teams have the same score.
- 10. Scheduled event Tee Time is forfeit time.
- 11. Event facilitator makes final decision.
